7. By the Agency you will have the goodness to have sent for the Botanic Garden here, a few cases or Packs of Barks, from the best sources or unobscured part of your Command, and to be taken within 12 inches from the surface.

8. At the same time if not already done, by the Amn, you will not fail to forward Returns in the various prescribed Forms, completed to the end of the Year, taking care the dates and other particulars are accurately inserted, to which I regret to observe, the proper attention does not appear, to have been paid in some cases. - The Agency will remain at Melville Island, but the Museum will convey hither, your Dispatches. Should any other opportunity however occur in the interim, it will be well to avail yourself of it, to send Publications.

9. - With this opportunity of transmitting for your information and guidance, a Copy of the Acts in Council, Government Order &c. issued during the latter half of the year 1826.
