By the arrival of the Brig Governor Phillip  
on the 31st December last I had the honor of receiving  
your despatches of the 10<sup>th</sup> of the same month, and also  
those of the 25 March 1829 by the Schooner Madeira Packet

submitted to the Governor I have now the directions of  
His Excellency to reply by the Schooner Mermaid under

me of the surrender of the Settlement at Raffles Bay to  
the Command of your successor Captn Barker, and
